PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR “MISS RODEO TEXAS”

Contract Term	Beginning on the Effective Date above and ending at the conclusion of the 2027 Miss Rodeo Texas Pageant unless otherwise extended as provided in this agreement.

For good and valuable consideration, the parties agree to the terms in this agreement.

Terms and Conditions

1. Definitions:

- a. “Image” shall refer to the name, voice, image, signature, video, or likeness (collectively referred to as “Image”) of Titleholder.
- b. “Marks” shall refer to U.S. Trademark Registration No. 1,195,392 issued May 11, 1982 to Miss Rodeo America, Inc., for the mark MISS RODEO TEXAS & Design; U.S. Trademark Reg. No. 1,195,393 issued May 11, 1982, for the mark MISS RODEO TEXAS and any other trademarks, logos or slogans used by MRTAI in connection with the State Pageant or Miss Rodeo Texas’ business of promoting the State Pageant and the sport of rodeo, whether registered or not.
- c. “MRTAI” shall refer to Miss Rodeo Texas Association, Inc.
- d. “MRAI” shall refer to Miss Rodeo America, Inc.
- e. “State Pageant” shall refer to the annual Miss Rodeo Texas Pageant conducted by MRTAI.
- f. “Public Appearance(s)” shall refer to any public appearance, event, or function where Titleholder is requested to appear. “Public Appearance(s)” include, but are not limited to: public appearances, interviews with the press and the public, public speeches, public photographs or photographs for advertising, marketing or publicity purposes, any video and/or sound recordings for advertising, marketing or publicity purposes, television and/or radio broadcasts (whether live or taped or otherwise recorded), marketing events, promotional events, rodeo events, Internet broadcasts or similar electronic media events or recordings, and such other events as may be designated by MRTAI.

g. "Titleholder" shall refer to the person named above as the Titleholder.

2. Background:

a. MRTAI is the owner of the Marks and has spent substantial time, effort, and money to develop, advertise, market, promote and protect the goodwill and reputation associated with the Marks.

b. Titleholder has taken part in the State Pageant conducted by MRTAI for the Pageant Year indicated above. Titleholder was selected as the winner of that State Pageant, following the rules and regulations for the MRTAI State Pageant.

c. As the winner of the State Pageant, upon full compliance with the Rules and Regulations of MRTAI for the State Pageant, and upon execution of this agreement Titleholder is eligible to receive the title of "Miss Rodeo Texas" and to use that title during the term of this agreement.

d. MRTAI desires to award such title to Titleholder and to have Titleholder represent MRTAI for the term of this agreement, to have Titleholder perform services as Miss Rodeo Texas, to perform the services set forth in this agreement, and such other services as the parties may agree, during the term set forth in this agreement.

e. Titleholder desires to receive the title of Miss Rodeo Texas for the term of this agreement, to represent MRTAI in accordance with the terms of this agreement, to perform the services as Miss Rodeo Texas for the term of this agreement, including the services set forth in this agreement and such other services as the parties may agree, in accordance with the terms of this agreement.

3. Appointment of Titleholder: MRTAI has selected and hereby appoints Titleholder as its representative, to represent MRTAI at such functions and Public Appearances as MRTAI may specify, and to generally promote MRTAI and the sport of Rodeo during the term of this agreement, and subject to the term set forth in this agreement.

4. Granting of Title "Miss Rodeo Texas":

a. MRTAI grants Titleholder the authority to use the title "MISS RODEO TEXAS" during the term of this agreement. MRTAI further grants Titleholder the right to use the Marks in connection with performing services for MRTAI as set forth in this agreement. Subject to Titleholder's full performance of this agreement, MRTAI agrees that it will not grant or authorize any other person permission or authority to use the title "MISS RODEO TEXAS" or any variation of such title during the term of this agreement.

b. Upon Titleholder's full performance of this agreement, then after termination of this agreement Titleholder may continue to use the designation "Former MISS RODEO TEXAS" or "MISS RODEO TEXAS [Pageant Year]" (e.g. "MISS RODEO TEXAS 2021") on resumes, historical or biographical information or the like; provided such designation is used in a truthful manner and it is clear from such usage that Titleholder is no longer actively representing MRTAI. Titleholder agrees to not use any designation of "MISS RODEO TEXAS" or photos referencing Titleholder as "MISS RODEO TEXAS" in conjunction with any competing sponsor to Miss Rodeo Texas Association, Inc. in photographs, print or audio advertisements, biographical text, social media, etc.

c. Notwithstanding the foregoing, MRTAI reserves the rights to: (i) allow “Miss Rodeo Texas Teen” or “Miss Rodeo Texas Princess,” should they request her to appear at any function on behalf of MRTAI, such as in the event of temporary illness or unavailability of Titleholder, or in the event of scheduling conflicts, or such other reason in MRTAI’s sole discretion; and (ii) allow the use of terms such as “Miss Rodeo Texas Teen”, “Miss Rodeo Texas Princess” or the like, for other pageants conducted or sponsored by MRTAI where the title includes a designation or indication of the type of contestant eligible to participate in such pageant and such eligibility (i.e. “teen”) distinguishes the pageant from the State Pageant.

5. Obligations of Titleholder:

a. Titleholder represents and warrants that she meets, and always during the term of this agreement, shall continue to meet all the eligibility requirements for Miss Rodeo Texas. A copy of the eligibility requirements is attached as Exhibit A to this agreement.

b. Titleholder shall appear at such time and place for the purpose of Public Appearances, as MRTAI shall direct, and shall, to the extent appropriate to such Public Appearance, participate in the public appearance, including giving interviews, and generally promote the goals of MRTAI, its sponsors, and the sport of Rodeo, consistent with the reasonable instructions and directions of MRTAI.

c. Titleholder shall appear and take part in the State Pageant for the year following her selection as Miss Rodeo Texas. She will preside as the reigning Miss Rodeo Texas at such State Pageant, until such time as her successor is chosen at the State Pageant. She shall fully participate in State Pageant, until the conclusion of the Pageant. Notwithstanding the foregoing, MRTAI at its option and in its sole discretion, may restrict or limit Titleholder’s involvement in the State Pageant.

d. Titleholder shall execute and deliver all contracts, agreements, releases, authorizations, endorsements, or other documents necessary or appropriate to perform the obligations set forth in this agreement.

e. Titleholder shall authorize and permit the recording, creation, use, and reproduction in any format or manner of Titleholder’s Image in any format during the term of this agreement (i) in any manner by or for the benefit of MRTAI, (ii) at any Public Appearance authorized by MRTAI, (iii) in any manner to advertise, market, promote or publicize MRTAI, or any of its sponsors, any event conducted by or sponsored by MRTAI or any Public Appearance, or (iv) in any other manner authorized by MRTAI during the term of this agreement. In addition, MRTAI shall have the perpetual right to authorize the reproduction after the termination of this agreement of any material incorporating Titleholder’s Image prepared or used during the term of this agreement. MRTAI or anyone authorized by it shall also have the right to reasonably edit the appearance of Titleholder’s Image to the extent necessary or appropriate in its reasonable judgment to all for the efficient publication, reproduction or distribution of any materials containing Titleholder’s Image.

f. Titleholder shall abide by the Social Media Guidelines and Expectations. A copy of the guidelines is included in the Miss Rodeo Texas Handbook that is attached as Exhibit C to this agreement. MRTAI will provide additional and specific information regarding social media to Titleholder in a timely manner.

- e. When making Public Appearances, and upon the request or directions of MRTAI, Titleholder shall appear in appropriate western apparel, and accoutrements consistent with the title Miss Rodeo Texas, including, but not limited to crown, banner, and buckle. Titleholder shall be perfectly groomed at all times, including but not limited to hair, makeup, and nails. All questions about appropriate apparel and grooming shall be directed to the MRTAI State Director.
- g. Titleholder shall have wardrobe including jewelry and accessories approved by the MRTAI State Director no less than 48 hours prior to a Public Appearance which also includes the State Pageant.
- h. Titleholder shall not be escorted to, from or during Public Appearances by anyone other than the official MRTAI Chaperone unless authorized by the MRTAI State Director in advance.
- i. Titleholder shall always act in manner to promote the best interests of MRTAI and the State Pageant. Titleholder shall not do anything that will or is reasonably likely to cause harm or damage to the goodwill and reputation of MRTAI or the State Pageant.
- j. Titleholder agrees that she is not under contract with any other entity (photographer, videographer, modeling agency, agent, coach, etc.).
- k. Titleholder agrees to perform such other activities as MRTAI may reasonably request.
- l. Titleholder agrees she is solely responsible for her personal property and physical well-being; and that she will not ask for, expect nor receive compensation or reimbursement from the MRTAI, the Board, Officers, or Agents, for any injury or loss sustained by her as a result of participating in the State Pageant or any activity under this Contract.
- m. Titleholder agrees to save and hold harmless MRTAI, its Board, Officers, Ambassadors, or Agents for and from any liability of her actions and conduct during her term as Miss Rodeo Texas and for its and their actions and conduct with respect to any rights granted herein.
- o. Titleholder agrees that if she receives use of a motor vehicle or trailer as Miss Rodeo Texas, she will solely be responsible for full coverage insurance covering those vehicles for said term.
- p. Titleholder agrees to follow Texas Law on liability insurance coverage if she uses a personal vehicle during her term as Miss Rodeo Texas.
- q. Titleholder agrees to reside in the state of Texas during her term as Miss Rodeo Texas.
- r. Titleholder understands that she cannot cohabitate with anyone during her term as Miss Rodeo Texas unless specifically authorized by MRTAI.
- s. Titleholder agrees she will not wear the crown, banner, or buckle from any other title or organization during her term as Miss Rodeo Texas.

t. Titleholder agrees to follow the General Rules as shown on in the Miss Rodeo Texas Handbook that is attached as Exhibit C to this agreement.

u. Titleholder agrees that she has read and will abide by the MRTAI Rules as shown in the Miss Rodeo Texas Handbook that is attached as Exhibit C to this agreement.

v. Titleholder agrees she will abide by the Perpetual Wardrobe Agreement as shown in the Miss Rodeo Texas Handbook that is attached as Exhibit C to this agreement.

w. Titleholder agrees that she has read and will abide by ALL sections of the MRTAI Handbook. A copy of the MRTAI Handbook is attached as Exhibit C to this agreement.

x. Titleholder agrees that she has seen and understands the Consequence Matrix as shown in Exhibit B of this agreement and the Miss Rodeo Texas Titleholder Handbook that is attached as Exhibit C to this agreement.

6. Exclusive Agent: Titleholder appoints MRTAI as her exclusive agent for the purpose of soliciting, negotiating, and contracting for Public Appearances for Titleholder during the term of this agreement.

7. Independent Contractor/Limitations of Authority:

a. Titleholder at all times is and shall remain an independent contractor providing services to MRTAI pursuant to the terms of this agreement. Nothing in this agreement shall make Titleholder an employee of MRTAI, nor an agent of MRTAI for any purpose other than performing the obligations set forth in this agreement.

b. Titleholder is appointed to represent MRTAI only in the manner authorized by this agreement. Titleholder is not authorized to represent MRTAI in any manner other than as expressly authorized by this agreement. Titleholder shall never, even after her reign has ended, use the title "Miss Rodeo Texas" to compete in any pageant or contest other than the Miss Rodeo America Pageant. Titleholder shall have no authority to enter into any agreements on behalf of MRTAI or to bind MRTAI in any transaction whatsoever; except only as expressly authorized in writing otherwise.

8. Obligations of MRTAI:

a. MRTAI shall use reasonable commercial efforts to obtain Public Appearances for Titleholder and to obtain proper compensation for those Public Appearances.

b. MRTAI shall use reasonable commercial efforts, consistent with its reasonable business judgment, to conduct the State Pageant, to promote the sport of Rodeo, and to publicize and promote the services of Titleholder for the promotion of the State Pageant and the sport of Rodeo, and the promotion of related activities.

c. MRTAI shall use reasonable commercial efforts to have Titleholder promote the sport of rodeo in the state of Texas.

d. Upon request from Titleholder, MRTAI shall periodically account to Titleholder for all sums due her.

e. During the term of this agreement and subject to Titleholder's full compliance with the terms of this agreement, MRTAI agrees that it shall not appoint any other person the right to use the title "MISS RODEO TEXAS", until Titleholder's successor is chosen at the next annual State Pageant.

f. MRTAI shall choose an official Chaperone to escort the Titleholder while traveling to or engaging in Public Appearances as deemed necessary.

9. Compensation / Reimbursement / Monetary Allowance: *For her services as specified herein, MRTAI shall pay or reimburse Titleholder:*

- a. \$40/day per diem for meals while making Public Appearances;
- b. Up to \$800/month for costs and expenses reasonably incurred by Titleholder for her attendance or performance at any Public Appearance scheduled by or approved by MRTAI;
- c. Such other monetary allowances and reimbursements as specified in Exhibit C - Miss Rodeo Texas Titleholder Handbook; and
- d. Fifty percent (50%) of all sums received by MRTAI for services rendered by Titleholder at all Public Appearances. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Titleholder shall not receive any added compensation for Public Appearances for MRTAI sponsors unless a paid appearance is negotiated by MRTAI.

Titleholder agrees to the Compensation, Reimbursement, and Monetary Allowances as shown in Exhibit C - Miss Rodeo Texas Titleholder Handbook.

10. Term:

- a. The term of this agreement shall begin on the effective date set forth above and shall terminate at the end of the contract term stated above, unless earlier terminated as provided for in this agreement.
- b. Option to Extend Term if Successor not Chosen or Qualified. In the event no subsequent Miss Rodeo Texas is chosen prior to the termination of this agreement, MRTAI shall have the right to extend this agreement beyond the termination date set forth herein. MRTAI shall pay and/or reimburse Titleholder for her services during this option period on the same basis as provided for in this agreement.

11. Termination:

- a. MRTAI shall have the right to terminate this agreement in the event of a material breach of this agreement by Titleholder if the breach is not cured within 15 days after notice is given. A non-inclusive consequence matrix is included as Exhibit B and is also included in the Miss Rodeo Texas Titleholder Handbook included as Exhibit C.

b. MRTAI shall have the right to immediately terminate this agreement by giving notice of such termination to Titleholder in the event: (i) of a material breach of any warranty or representation by Titleholder; (ii) it is determined that Titleholder does not meet the eligibility requirements; (iii) it is determined that Titleholder has made a materially false statement during her participation in the State Pageant where she was selected as “Miss Rodeo Texas”, in any activity leading up to her selection as “Miss Rodeo Texas”, or in any other respect during her performance of her obligations under this agreement; or (iv) Titleholder takes any action or is involved in any event which will or is likely to cause harm or damage to the reputation or goodwill of MRTAI or the State Pageant.

c. Titleholder may terminate this agreement upon a material breach of this agreement if breach is not cured within 15 days after notice of such breach is given to MRTAI.

d. Upon termination of this agreement for any reason, Titleholder shall return all property of MRTAI to MRTAI. Such property includes, but is not limited to the Miss Rodeo Texas crown and banners, perpetual wardrobe, and any other indicia of the office of Miss Rodeo Texas Inc. In addition, except as otherwise expressly provided in this agreement, upon termination of this agreement, Titleholder shall immediately cease the use of the term MISS RODEO TEXAS and any of the Marks in connection with any future Public Appearances (except as may be otherwise authorized in writing by MRTAI).

e. Upon termination of this agreement under the terms of paragraphs 11(a) or 11(b) above, Titleholder shall forfeit any rights to any prizes awarded to her as a result of her being granted the title of “Miss Rodeo Texas” or any other prizes awarded to her at the State Pageant, which had not yet been distributed or delivered to her.

f. Right to Injunctive Relief. Titleholder acknowledges and agrees that the Marks are valuable property of MRAI. Therefore, upon a breach of this agreement, Titleholder acknowledges that MRAI, or MRTAI on behalf of MRAI, shall be entitled to injunctive relief to restrain or prohibit any use or threatened use of the Marks by Titleholder, in addition to any other remedies available to MRAI, or MRTAI on behalf of MRAI, at law or in equity.

12. Personal Services/No Assignment or Delegation: This nature of this contract requires that all obligations of Titleholder are personal in nature. Therefore, Titleholder agrees that she shall personally appear and represent MRTAI at all events and functions scheduled by MRTAI. Titleholder agrees that she shall personally perform all functions required of her under the terms of this agreement. Under no circumstances shall Titleholder assign or delegate any of her obligations under the terms of this agreement.

13. Ownership and Use of Intellectual Property:

- a. All right, title and interest in and to the Marks is owned by MRAI. Any use of the Marks by or in connection with the services provided by Titleholder shall ensure the benefit of MRTAI. Upon termination of this agreement, Titleholder shall immediately return all materials in her possession or control bearing or containing the Marks.
- b. Titleholder acknowledges and agrees that all right, title, and interest in and to any copyrighted works created during the performance of this agreement shall be owned exclusively by MRTAI. To the extent necessary, Titleholder assigns all rights, title, and interest she may have in any copyrighted works to MRTAI.
- c. Titleholder grants MRTAI the perpetual and irrevocable right to use any Images of Titleholder created during the term of this agreement in any manner it deems appropriate. MRTAI shall further have the right to authorize third parties to use such images.

14. Participation in Rodeo and Other Activities: During the term of this agreement, Titleholder may be asked to participate in certain Rodeo activities, related activities, or other activities where horses, livestock and other large animals may be present or involved. Titleholder represents and warrants that she is experienced in these and similar activities. These activities are or may be inherently risky. Titleholder states that she is aware of the risks of being involved in these activities. Titleholder represents and warrants that she is voluntarily participating in these activities knowing the potential risks involved. Titleholder releases and discharges MRTAI from all liability of every kind and nature that may be involved in participating in these types of activities.

15. General Provisions:

- a. Notice: All notices permitted or required under this agreement shall be in writing and shall be personally delivered, delivered by overnight courier (such as FedEx), or certified mail. Notices shall be effective upon receipt, if personally delivered or delivered by overnight courier, or 5 days after deposit in the mail, if sent by certified mail.
- b. Modification: This agreement may be modified or amended only by a written instrument signed by all the parties.
- c. No Waiver (Failure to Enforce): The waiver or failure of the parties to exercise in any respect any right provided for herein shall not be deemed a waiver of that right and shall not prevent any party from enforcing that right later.
- d. Execution of Further Documents: The parties agree to execute such other and further documents as may be necessary to effectuate this agreement.

e. Arbitration: In the event of a dispute between the parties arising out of or related to this agreement, the dispute shall be resolved by binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association. Such arbitration shall be held in a reasonable location in Texas as deemed appropriate by MRTAI.

f. Attorneys' Fees and Costs: In any legal action or arbitration brought arising out of or related to this agreement, the prevailing party shall recover its court or arbitration costs and its reasonable attorneys' fees incurred in such action.

g. Governing Law: This agreement and performance hereunder shall be governed by the laws of the United States and the State of Texas. All the parties' consent to the jurisdiction and venue of the state and federal courts located in San Antonio, Texas for any matter arising out of this agreement.

h. Integration: This agreement expresses the entire understanding of the parties regarding its subject matter, and it supersedes and merges all prior written or oral proposals, agreements or understandings between the parties relating to the subject matter of this agreement.

i. Right to Counsel: Titleholder states that she has been recommended to have counsel review this contract before executing it and that she has either received the advice of counsel or has knowingly exercised her judgment in declining to have counsel review this agreement before execution.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

By signing below, I confirm that I meet all the eligibility requirements set forth below.

1. **Age:** I will be 21 years of age by November 1 of the Pageant year, and I will be no older than 26 years of age by December 31 of the Pageant year. Upon request, I will provide a copy of a government issued identification (such as a birth certificate, driver's license, passport, etc.) verifying my age.
2. **U.S. Citizen:** I am a citizen or lawful resident of the United States of America and authorized to work in the United States of America.
3. **Resident of State:** I am a resident of the State of Texas and have been for at least one year by the first day of the current year's Miss Rodeo Texas Pageant.
4. **Education:** I have obtained a high school diploma (or equivalent) and will provide proof thereof upon request.
5. **Gender:** I was assigned female at birth, and I am female.
6. **Marital Status:** I am not currently married, have never been married, nor had a marriage annulled. I will not get engaged during my term as Miss Rodeo Texas.
7. **Parental Status:** I am not a parent of any child, and I am not pregnant, nor will I become pregnant during my term as Miss Rodeo Texas.
8. **Good Character:** I am of good moral character. I have never committed or been involved in an act of moral turpitude.
9. **No Criminal Record:** I have not been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor crime (excluding minor traffic offenses). I agree to allow MRTAI to run a background check.
10. **Health:** I am in good health, and I do not have any health concerns which would prevent me from fully participating in this contest or from serving as Miss Rodeo Texas if selected.
11. **Substance Abuse:** I do not use any illegal or controlled substances (other than prescription medications and then only in the manner prescribed). I do not abuse alcohol or drugs.
12. **Contractual Obligations:** I am not under any contractual obligation which would interfere with my ability to participate in this contest or interfere with my ability to perform as Miss Rodeo Texas, if selected.
13. **No other Competitions:** If selected as Miss Rodeo Texas, I will not compete in any other pageant of any kind during my term other than the Miss Rodeo America Pageant.
14. **No Previous Miss Rodeo America Competitions:** I have not been a contestant in any prior year's Miss Rodeo America Pageant.
15. **No Other Acts Detrimental to Reputation:** I have not engaged in any act, which if made public, would be likely to cause harm or damage to my reputation or to the goodwill and reputation of Miss Rodeo Texas, Inc. (If I have any concerns about the applicability of this provision, I acknowledge I have been advised to discuss this with the Miss Rodeo Texas State Director prior to signing this form.)
16. **Ability to Perform:** To the best of my knowledge, there is nothing that will interfere with my ability to compete in this contest or to perform the obligations of Miss Rodeo Texas, if selected.
