

Miss Rodeo Texas Job Description

Summary:

Miss Rodeo Texas (MRT) is recognized as the First Lady of Professional Rodeo for Texas. She is an independent contractor responsible for representing and promoting Miss Rodeo Texas Association, Inc. (MRTAI), the Miss Rodeo Texas Pageant (MRTP), the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) and the sponsors and entities associated with MRTAI and the PRCA as well as the agricultural industry and our cherished farming and ranching heritage.

Key Qualifications, Responsibilities, and Duties:

- Strive with every appearance and action to uphold, support and further the Mission of Miss Rodeo Texas Association, Inc. (Mission Statement included at the end of this document)
- Dignity and Professionalism should be apparent while representing the above entities at rodeos, events, activities, and while traveling.
- Work with the MRTAI State Director or their designee to ensure all scheduled appearances are attended, and the travel schedule provided is adhered to.
- Work with the MRTAI Social Media Director to provide pictures, descriptions, details and any other material requested or required in a timely manner.
- Work with the State Director of MRTAI to prioritize and carry out objectives relating to promotion of the program, the PRCA, sponsors and partner entities.
- Act as a role model for all rodeo queens during travels in appearance, personality, horsemanship, knowledge and interactions with rodeo committees, rodeo fans, sponsors, and the general public.
- Provide an accounting of expenses and follow the accounting guidelines as provided by the MRTAI State Director in a timely manner.
- Help prepare for and plan, as requested, for the annual Miss Rodeo Texas Pageant and act as a hostess for the Pageant.
- Be able to speak, often extemporaneously, appropriately and accurately about Miss Rodeo Texas, the PRCA, the sport of rodeo, local events being attended or other matters as requested. This may include television or radio appearances as scheduled or improvised.
- Must always meet the eligibility requirements as listed in the Miss Rodeo Texas rulebook.
- Must have and maintain a valid driver's license to operate a vehicle in the United States.

- Must be selected by the panel of judges at the annual Miss Rodeo Texas Pageant or be officially designated as Miss Rodeo Texas by the Executive Board of MRTAI.
- Must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Must have experience and proficiency with social media.
- Must have excellent organizational skills.
- Must have financial responsibility in dealing with expense accounts and expense reporting.
- Must have the ability to work constructively and cooperatively with other members of the MRTAI team.

Time Commitment, Conditions and Physical Requirements:

- Miss Rodeo Texas' schedule is demanding and will consist of many days with long hours. Days of travel may also require appearance responsibilities.
- Significant travel, including air travel, is required throughout the year. MRT is required to be able to travel independently via commercial aircraft and by driving a vehicle. This includes independently navigating airports including transporting personal luggage to, from and through the airport.
- Significant time on horseback is required and MRT must be physically able to mount, dismount and sit in the saddle and ride unassisted for extended periods of time, including inclement weather. She must be a skilled equestrian, able to ride unfamiliar horses of all abilities and levels and must have the judgement to be able to determine if a horse is unsafe to ride. Mounts will be provided by a local source. All tack/equipment used will also be provided.
- Must be able to saddle and unsaddle a horse unassisted, if required, including placing the saddle on the horse and including appropriate adjustments of the saddle and all tack required to ride.
- Must be able to carry a flag on horseback both standing and at speed.
- Miss Rodeo Texas will experience all kinds of weather during her reign and must be able to withstand heat, cold, rain and other forms of inclement weather.
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time at receptions, meet & greet events, sponsor visits, etc.

Compensation and Benefits:

- Compensation and benefits will be determined by the Executive Board of Miss Rodeo Texas Association, Inc. and as set forth in the Personal Services Contract.

Miss Rodeo Texas Mission Statement:

To provide a quality state pageant, maintaining an environment where contestants, participants and committee members will be enriched by the experience of the pageant. To provide scholarships for educational opportunities.
