Embellishments may be added to the pants and/or shirt. The shirt and jeans can be dyed but do not have to be. Must wear boots, cowboy hat, belt and buckle. No vests or jackets.</p> <p>Red Boot Round-up &amp; AQHA Contestants must wear a casual all-denim ensemble paired with red boots. Acceptable denim pieces include a shirt, jeans, pant jumpsuit, dress, vest, or jacket. Shorts are not permitted. A cowboy hat, belt, and buckle are required to complete the look. Denim garments may include tasteful embellishments; however, excessively distressed denim or styles with holes are not allowed. Red boots must remain unaltered, no embellishments or decorative additions are permitted. Off-the-rack denim is encouraged, and there are no brand restrictions for this outfit. This is a semi-outdoor event held in Texas in June. Warm weather should be expected, and misters may be in use at the venue. Saturday, June 20	Category Winners/All Awards Pickup and Photoshoot  Contract Signing	Same Western Elegance dress/skirt with blouse and/or jacket/vest, boots, cowboy hat, belt & buckle that was worn for coronation the night before.
